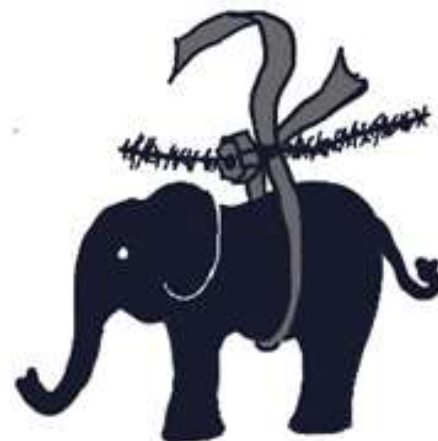


Talisman
