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World Book Day

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Jungledrop

You will need: A pen or pencil, some paper, your imagination.

Step one: Read the below description of *Jungledrop*.

Jungledrop by Abi Elphinstone is the fantastic second book in The Unmapped Chronicles. It follows Fox and Fibber as they discover the Unmapped Kingdom, which bizarrely controls the weather in our world!

During the story, Fox and Fibber end up in the glow-in-the-dark forest full of golden panthers and enchanted temples.

Step two: Imagine you are in the forest too, what can you see around you? What smells can you detect? Are there any unusual noises? How do you feel? Write down all of your ideas on a page.

Step three: When you have all your ideas, expand each word into a sentence. For example, “leaves” might become “waxy, green leaves hanging from mid-air”.

Step four: Finally, choose an order you like and add all your sentences together. You have now created an amazing poem all about the forest!

Step five: Share your writing with us! Do this by taking a photo of your handwritten poem, typing up your work, or make an audio or video recording of yourself reading it aloud (you could also ask someone else to read it aloud for you).
