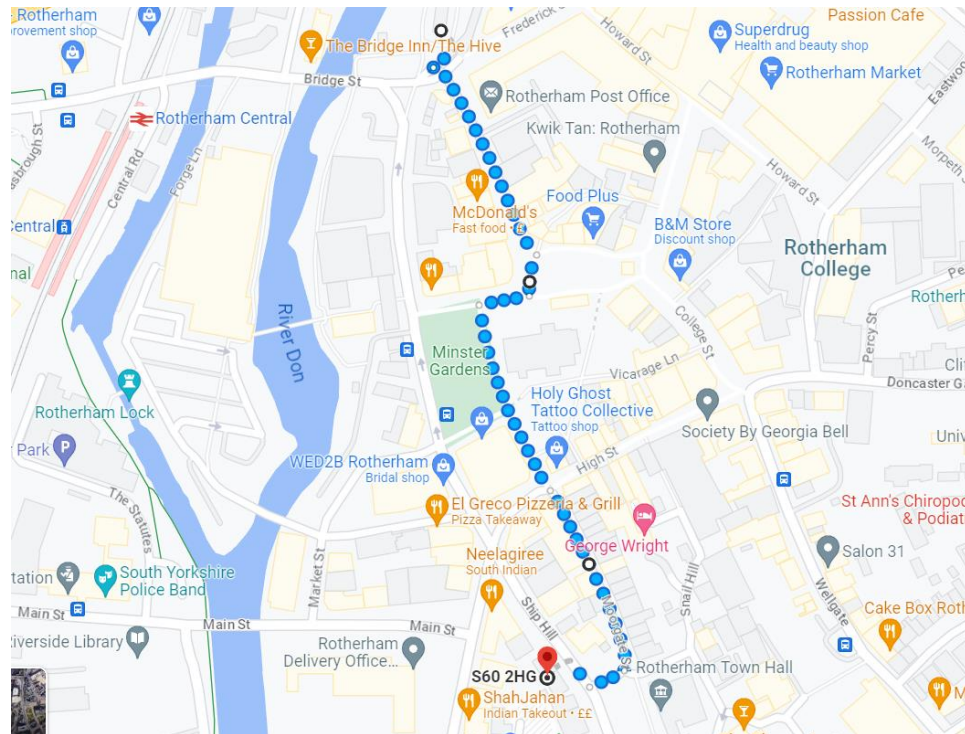


Getting to Grimm & Co by bus:



The Grimm & Co address is Ship Hill, Rotherham, S60 2HG. The What3Words reference for the front door is shovels.successes.stage.

Rotherham Bus Station, also sometimes referred to as Rotherham Bus Interchange, is 0.3 miles/490m from Grimm & Co and the postcode is S60 1EY.

The bus station has level access throughout. Interchange staff are available to help at the Customer Services point between stands B5 and B6. This is open 7am to 7pm, six days a week (closed Sundays). More details about the Interchange are available here - <https://www.travelsouthyorkshire.com/en-GB/LandingPage/bus-interchanges>.

The route from the bus station to Grimm & Co is tarmac or concrete slab pavement with drop kerbs at crossings.

To reach Grimm & Co, exit the bus station concourse via its south-west exit. The south-west exit is where buses both enter and exit the bus station, and is the exit that is closest to Rotherham town centre.



Upon exiting the bus station, cross Frederick Street and go up Corporation Street.

(There is another exit from Rotherham Interchange, which brings you out into a covered concourse, past Greggs and Select Convenience store).



Exit this concourse and turn right onto Frederick Street. Follow this street to the end of the pedestrianised section and turn left onto Bridgegate, passing The County pub on your right-hand side. Head up towards the Minster, which stands in front of you, passing the Post Office on your left and McDonalds on your right. There are dropped kerbs to the pedestrianised area.



Turn slightly right at the top, when you arrive at All Saints Square, and turn left to head up the hill with the Minster on your left. The surface here is cobbled, but these are level and smooth. The Heart of Steel will be on your right-hand side.

Continue up past the Imperial buildings on your right and cross the pedestrianised High Street onto Moorgate Street. Be aware that although this is pedestrianised, delivery vehicles may access this area.



Continue up Moorgate Street towards the Town Hall, a large white building on your left-hand side. Once you arrive here, the area opens out into a square with benches available, and Grimm & Co is the large building on your right, next door to Howells Solicitors, opposite the Town Hall and seated bench area.

There are dropped kerb crossings at both sides of the square to cross to Grimm & Co.

This route is mostly uphill, but there are benches on route if you require a break during the journey.



There is a bus stop in front of the Grimm & Co building on Ship Hill. This is serviced by a number of buses, including 19, 19a, 20 and 21. The bus stop number for the YourNextBus service is 37030495. Information on bus timetables can be found here - <https://journeyplanner.travelsouthyorkshire.com/>
